excerpt from reflections on violence during twenty years i worked to deliver myself from what i retained of my education i read books not so much to learn as to efface from my memory the ideas which had been thrust upon it it is only during the last fifteen years that i have really worked for the purpose of learning but i have never found any one to teach me what i wanted to know i have had to be my own master and in a way to educate myself i make notes in which i formulate my thoughts as they arise i return three or four times to the same question adding correo tions which amplify the original and sometimes even transform it from top to bottom i only stop when i have exhausted the reserve of ideas stirred up by recent reading this work is very
